## Leprechaun Drama Club

**Parents:** Your little Leprechaun might want to dress up for this role play. Although it would be wonderful if you or your child's siblings can participate in Drama Club, your child can act out this Drama Club on their own. If you don't want your little Leprechaun to gather items from around your home (not knowing what they will get into), you can restrict them to one room or have them take photos of the items (if you trust them with your phone). You might want to block the Leprechaun's path with cushions or hang bells from doorknobs to "catch" them.

#### **Drama Club Directions**

Pretend you are a Leprechaun. Quietly sneak around your home and search for things you love: the color green, things that are gold, rainbows, unicorns, and shiny things. [Parents: add here whether your child should collect the items or take photos.] You need to sneak past any humans you see.

After you find your items you can talk to a human and ask them to send you back to Ireland. They might pretend to mail you home in a box!
